1 INT. BEDROOM - MORNING

1

BEEP. BEEP. BEEP. An alarm clock monotonously rings.

We are looking at a ceiling. It is somewhat blurry. The rest of the room slowly slides into view.

Everything in the room is vaguely obscured. The books, the closet, the lamp. They are all out of focus.

Cynical JOSEPH (16), a jaded high school student sits in his bed looking around. He appears dazed and squints as he looks around.

JOSEPH (V.O.)

Joseph tries to hit the alarm clock. In his attempt to turn it off he knocks it of the night stand.

JOSEPH

Damn it!

Joseph steps out of bed and runs into a few things on the way to the bathroom. He squints as he struggles to see.

2 INT. BATHROOM - MORNING

The bathroom light flickers on. Joseph steps in and stares into his reflection. His reflection is blurry. His eyes carry a red tinge. Frustration is evident in his gaze.

3 EXT. SIDEWALK - DAY

Joseph slowly walks down the sidewalk with difficulty.

Joseph stumbles over a crack in the sidewalk and falls to the ground hard.

JOSEPH

Shit!

Joseph pounds the ground in rage and frustration. He eventually stops and looks at the ground, hopeless.

FADE TO BLACK.

FADE IN:

4 INT. BEDROOM - MORNING

4

TWO YEARS LATER

BEEP. BEEP. BE-SMACK! Joseph, now (18) slams his hand down on the alarm clock to shut it off.

Joseph sits up in bed. He looks more rugged, older. The entire room is now barely visible from his perspective.

Joseph sits in rumination. He hears the voice of a somber DOCTOR (40) in his head.

DOCTOR (V.O.)
Unfortunately Joseph going
completely blind is inevitable. He
experiences a condition called
retinopathy of prematurity.

Joseph drags himself out of bed and looks around, though he can barely see.

DOCTOR (V.O.)

Because Joseph was born twenty two weeks premature as you noted, the result is that he will continue to gradually lose his sight over time. I'm very sorry.

Joseph grabs a book and hurls it across the room. He slowly slides on a pair of dark sunglasses resting on his night stand.

5 EXT. HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS - DAY

Joseph walks up to a pretty dead campus. He sports the black sunglasses and uses a walking cane to find his way. He stops and looks at the school, as much as he can see of it.

We can make out very little of the campus from Joseph's perspective. Suddenly a small student appears out of nowhere.

Joseph accidentally knocks over brilliant GENE (16) a small and frail student who is socially inept. Gene's books and papers scatter everywhere as he hits the ground.

JOSEPH

What the hell is wrong with you! Are you fucking blind!? Because I am, so what's your excuse.

Gene scrambles to attain his books and papers.

GENE

Sin, cosign, sin?

Gene's eyes frantically dart back and forth. His movements are frantic and neurotic. He wears big glasses and looks at Joseph with wide eyes. He grabs Joseph's sleeve.

GENE (CONT'D)

Or is it tangent!?

JOSEPH

Get off me you twerp! Don't touch me again or I'll use this cane.

GENE

But statistically speaking, the chances of you bashing my head in with that cane before security makes it over to us are not very good.

JOSEPH

Shut up!

Joseph starts to walk away.

GENE

That is not a rational response.

Joseph turns and starts to stumble back toward Gene.

JOSEPH

If you don't-

GENE

Calculating your speed over time vs. my speed over time means you can't catch me!

Gene jumps to his feet and bolts. Joseph watches him run away, dazed.

JOSEPH

That little shit.

6 EXT. HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS - DAY

The bell rings. Joseph walks across campus and is approached by snobbish CALEIGH (18).

CALEIGH

Question.

JOSEPH

What?

CALEIGH

(Sarcastically)

Want to see a movie this Friday?

Caleigh laughs mockingly. There is pain in Joseph's expression.

JOSEPH

(Under his breath)

Bitch.

Joseph walks away as Caleigh smirks. Joseph continues to walk with his cane. Dorky BRENT (18) approaches and claps Joseph on the back.

BRENT

Dude, what's up my man?

JOSEPH

Don't touch me.

BRENT

You sure got a stick up your ass.

JOSEPH

Yeah try going blind.

Joseph walks away leaving Brent to watch him go.

7 EXT. BEHIND HIGH SCHOOL - DAY

Joseph leans up against a wall and drops his cane. He takes his glasses off and tries to see. Very little is visible from his perspective.

We see a dumpster and faint glimpses of the sky and the trees.

Joseph rubs his eyes in frustration.

GENE (O.S.)

Hi!

Joseph turns his head to make out the image of Gene sitting on a dumpster.

JOSEPH

What the hell are you doing? Beat it four eyes!

Gene hops off the dumpster and holds a calculator.

GENE

I'd rather have four eyes than none. Also, I'm Gene and I love numbers. Hi.

Joseph grabs his cane and stumbles over to Gene.

JOSEPH

Get lost!

Gene punches in a few numbers into the calculator. The number 2 is on the screen.

GENE

Err! Wrong! Sorry. According to my calculations, two threats don't make a right.

Joseph drops his cane and grabs Gene by the shirt.

JOSEPH

What in the hell do you want and why the fuck won't you leave me alone?

GENE

Well. I've been watching you and you think the world is so ugly. I just wanted to show you that the world is beautiful. And we get to experience three hundred and sixty five days of it a year.

JOSEPH

You can't show me anything. I can't see shit!

GENE

You aren't looking. You don't have to use your eyes.

8 EXT. FIELD - DAY

8

JOSEPH (O.S.)

9 INT. BEDROOM - DAY

9

We see the beautiful wavy hair of A PRETTY GIRL (18).

PRETTY GIRL

Look at me.

We turn to get a full view of her face as she smiles at us.

JOSEPH (O.S.)

How beautiful the human face is.

PRETTY GIRL

Come here.

She leans toward us as if to kiss us. Her hair falls over face as blinding white light fills the screen.

10 EXT. FIELD - DAY

10

A field is blurry and dark. The grass appears to go black as the color drains out of the field.

JOSEPH (O.S.)

And now the color has been drained from everything. My world is going black.

11 EXT. BEHIND HIGH SCHOOL - DAY

11

Joseph looks down, dejected.

JOSEPH

I just want to see it all again. I just want to see it.

GENE

It doesn't mean you can't see. Just look through things with a new lens. Switch numbers for letters. Capish?

Gene hops back onto the dumpster. Joseph looks up into the sky. Tears slowly trickle down his face. Joseph cries in frustration, longing.

GENE (CONT'D)

Your seat is over here. Follow my voice.

Joseph wipes his eyes and slowly makes his way to the dumpster.

GENE (CONT'D)

See two peas make a pod. I double checked my math.

Gene holds up the 2 on his calculator. Joseph hops onto the dumpster and sits next to Gene.

We see quick flashes of the FLOWER, the SKY, the FIELD and the face of the PRETTY GIRL.

Joseph and Gene watch the sky. Joseph smiles.

JOSEPH

What a view.
